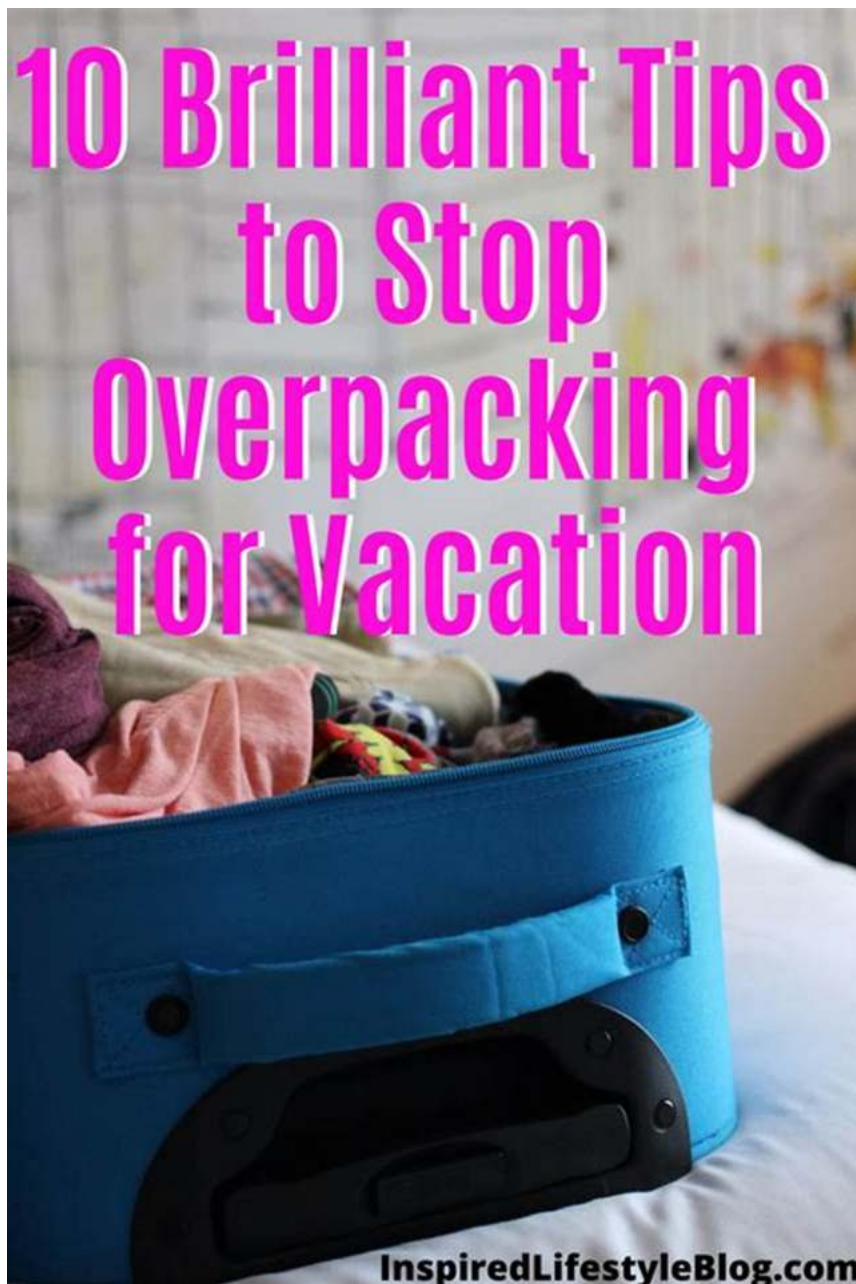

Do: Plan Parks
Plan your park days. Head to the park with well evening magic hours the night before.
- 3

Do: Travel Agent
Use an authorized Disney travel planner! You'll get the ins and outs of Disney and it totally freed!
- 4

Do: Discounts
Know when discounts and special offers are available and book during these times.
- 5

Do: Plan Dining
Dining opens 180 days before arrival. The most popular locations and times go fast! Book early, you can always cancel.

Do: Plan Ahead
Plan on booking as soon as discounts are released, you'll have the most room choices available.

Do: Set a Budget
Think about your budget and then consider adding 10-20%. That will give you money for souvenirs, snacks, etc.

Make your FastPass+ reservations for early in the day and then schedule most of an important new tool. Use it!

Don't: Early EMH
Go to the park with early morning magic hours buttes you plan on getting there before the park opens and you have park happen!
- 2

Don't: Holidays
Don't leave your major holidays. It's extremely crowded and expensive, especially Christmas or New Year's.
- 3

Don't: Walk Up
Don't expect to walk up to a table service restaurant and get in. You'll almost always need a reservation.
- 4

Don't: Underbudget
Budget for table service meals, souvenirs, food in general, airfare, etc.
- 5

Don't: Stay all day
Take a break from the park! You'll need it to make it through multiple park days. Don't burn out.
- 6

Don't: Waste \$\$\$
Don't waste your money. Plan for the appropriate # of park days. Use all of your dining credits!
- 7

Don't: Ferry Boat
Don't take the ferry boat to the Epcot transportation center. It's a huge bottleneck and it's slow!
- 8

Don't: Go in Blind
Know how Disney transportation works and how to appropriately get from here to there.
- 9

Don't: Do it all
Don't try and do everything in one day, especially in Magic Kingdom. Slow down and enjoy the magic.

You have a schedule and if it goes bad, don't worry. You can always get back on track.

Read the policy, especially the section labeled "List of Covered Reasons" for trip cancellation



GET MEDICAL ABROAD

Your insurance from home may not cover you when you leave the country, package plans include medical emergency coverage



FILTER FOR PRE-EX

Most plans can cover Pre-Existing Conditions if you buy early enough. Use the filters to find plans when comparing



COVER EXPENSIVE TRIPS

Rule of thumb: Insure trips that cost more than you are willing to lose if cancelled. Cruises, tours, anything \$\$



COMPARE TO SAVE \$\$

Get the best coverage and price by comparing plans from all companies. Use a comparison tool



WAIT TO BUY IT

Some vital coverages are available, but only if you buy with 14 days of initial deposit



ASSUME IT'S COVERED

Travel insurance is "named peril"...it covers what is specifically listed. Check what is covered (and for how much)



RELY ON CREDIT CARDS

They may have some benefits, but the amount is limited and it totally lacks some essential coverage (like medical)



CHECK THE BOX

Skip the "Add insurance?" box when booking your trip...you have zero choice in companies & plans, and are too rushed



IGNORE ACTIVITIES

Special activities like SCUBA and zip-lining can be covered with the right add-on coverage

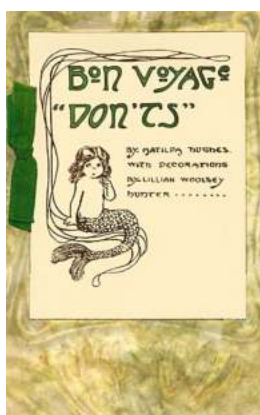

Originally published in April, 1912, in New York, Bon Voyage Don'ts is essentially a small picture book, with a brief etiquette “Don't” for the ocean-going traveller on each page presented in art nouveau style and accompanied by Kewpie-like characters as illustration.

Numbering twenty-three in all, these humorous and satirical Bon Voyage Don'ts were published in the hey-day of ocean liner travel yet most still resonate today. One of the “Dont's” is an innocently flippant travel tip not to be afraid of icebergs, whilst others cover such topics as (not) eating every time food is on offer, drinking champagne unless the ship is rolling, leaning over the rail, smiling too often at the

bath steward or getting snippy with the stewardess . . . for reasons to be found in the booklet!

The intervening years, however, left their mark. Some imperfections remain, though most has been restored, modified for e-publication or kept as-is, such as the charming inscription admonishing the recipient “to be sure and observe all these rules”.
