

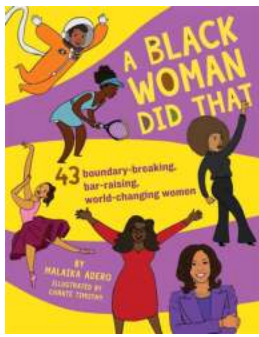

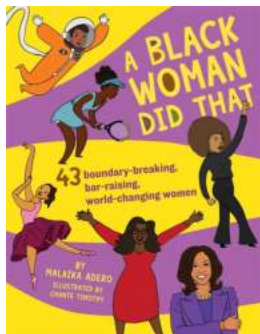

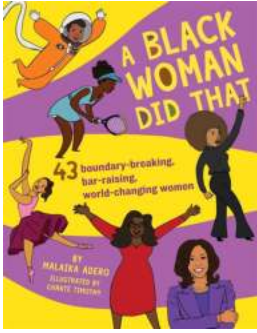
How could it be wrong to save the children by starting an orphanage? Oh, in so many ways . . .
