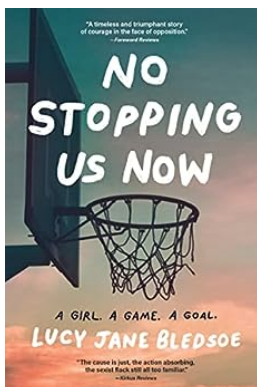


A Nickel Tour of the Magic Kingdom
