I am a Chartered Surveyor. Moscow 1997 to 1999 was my first overseas posting, and one to a city at an unusual time in its history.

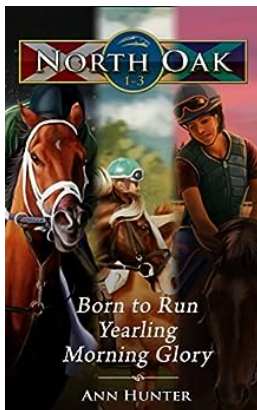
I have written a very honest book about my life and adventures in Moscow 15 years ago.

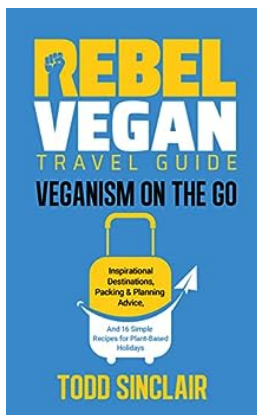

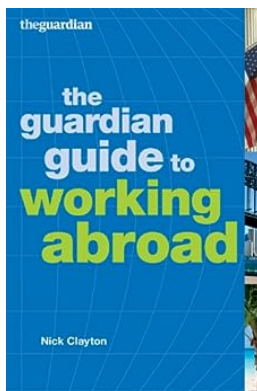

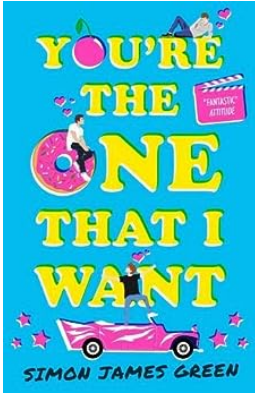
