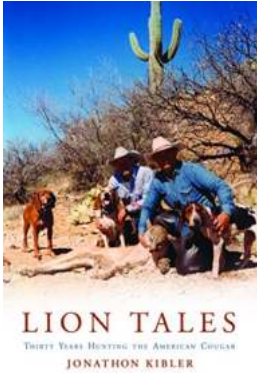

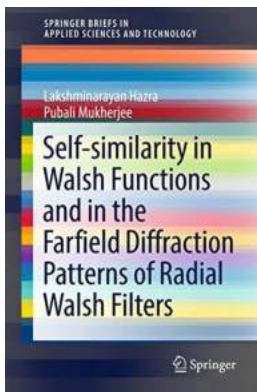

Jonathon Kibler, a cougar-hunting specialist, has been hunting American lions since his early teens. Kibler has followed a lion into a pitch-black cave with an ice-cold underground pool, dealt with a tom cat that eluded him for more than two years, and taken lions sitting on ledges mere inches wide and hundreds of yards up a steep cliff. *Lion Tales* contains some of the most interesting stories ever written on hunting mountain lions in the United States.



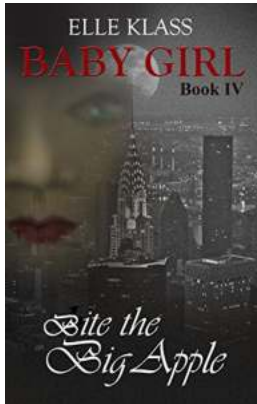
