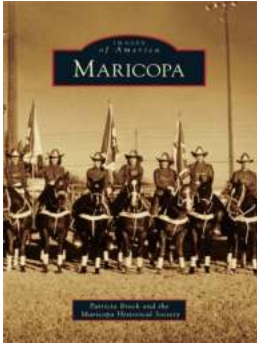

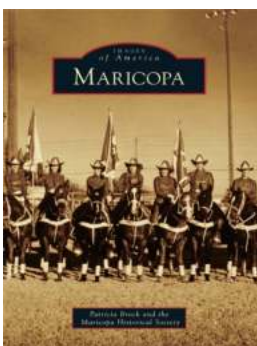

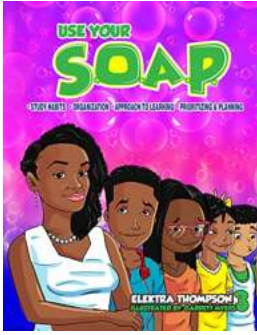


The Hohokam built an extensive network of canals with sticks and stone hoes, but mysteriously disappeared in 1450. Today its population continues to grow with more than 40,000 inhabitants from all over the United States and world.



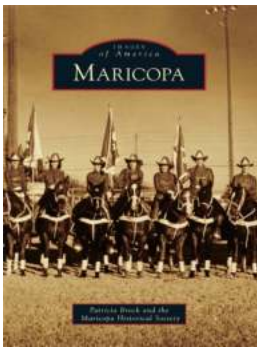

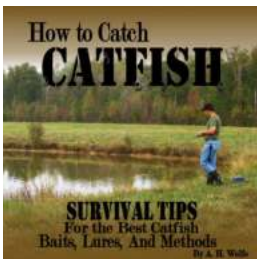

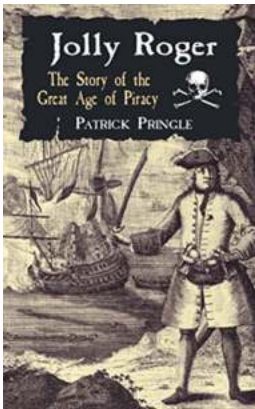
