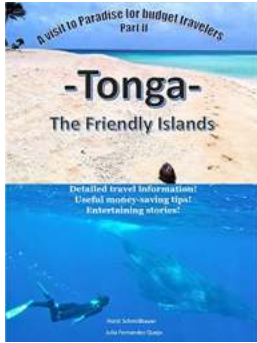

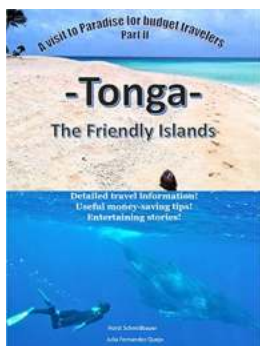

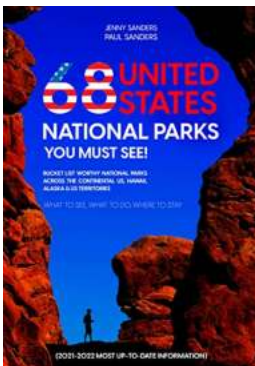

How it worked out and which other interesting escapades we were allowed to experience on „The friendly Islands“ you can read in this travel report.

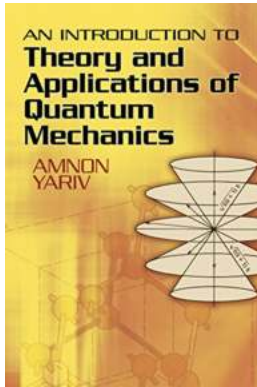

Because in the first place the intention of this book is to motivate our readers to enrich their lives by enjoying similarly awe-inspiring experiences!



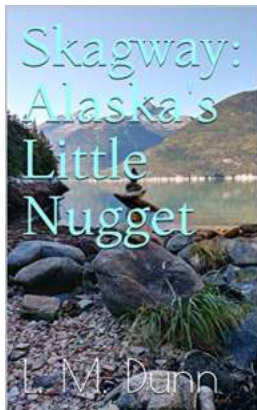

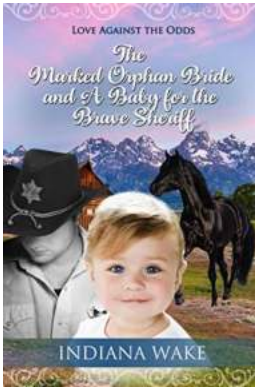

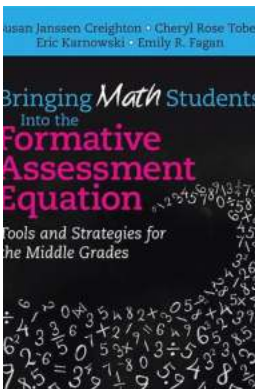
