
Rising competition



There are serious concerns over tourism development issue in CEE region: Accelerated integration process which has direct effect on tourism demand and supply; direct investments in the region in the state of notable disparities between countries that may leave these new independent states vulnerable to the power of transnational corporations; sensitivity of the region's tourism to international development programmes; unequal availability of transport service throughout Europe; the lack of long-term management of tourism profile and market positioning in the region; challenges over integrated strategies of branddevelopment in the region; inappropriate approaches for integrated tourism policy for the region; challenges of promoting cultural heritage tourism during integration and so on. Clearly, support of tourism in the region requires careful consideration of development process. A major factor in achieving sustainable development is to be able to meet these challenges. Critical to value and logic of this dissertation is an understanding of what type of support is required to boost sustainable tourism development in the region. Understanding the evolution of tourism and its growth trends and impediments for sustainable development of tourism is therefore an area worth studying and would contribute to the knowledge of tourism development in CEE. Apart from the fact of very poor availability of literature on the topic, the importance of studying this field of tourism development becomes even more apparent when researchers mention the

inevitability of new approaches for development of tourism in the region as complex (Williams and Balaz 2000).

A major focus of this dissertation will concentrate on the development of tourism in CEE region investigating challenges which constrains the sustainable growth. What are the challenges impeding growth and sustainable development of tourism in this particular region? What main challenges do "transformation" process and European integration pose to tourism development? Do political factors impede the development of heritage in CEE? How does historical evolution of tourism affect the current development in the region? To gain a deeper understanding of these issues this dissertation includes a review of relevant literature to ascertain current research findings and potential barriers. Thus, the section of 'literature review' focuses on the identification of challenges for development of tourism in the region referring to the available literature. Further, to gain a meaningful picture of the trends of tourism development in the region, including barriers and drivers, it is important to place current development


process of region in a wider context of historical evolution. Thus, the third section will provide an overview of the history of evolution of tourism in the region and will illustrate current development trends. Afterwards, before drawing s, the factors challenging the development of heritage tourism in CEE will be examined indepth in the fourth section.

The overall aim of this dissertation is to advance understanding of the challenges to tourism development in CEE region. Moreover, in order to understand the environment that that 'hosts' barriers to development it is felt necessary to gain insight into the development trends of tourism throughout its evolution history. These objectives are not seen as independent of each other, rather they are necessarily interlinked.






