

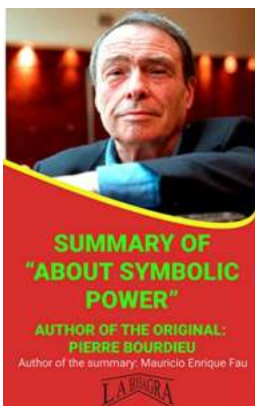

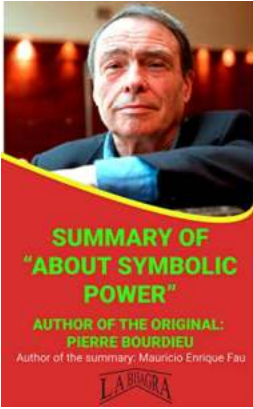

There are authors and schools of thought (Kantian idealists such as Humboldt or Cassirer, linguists such as Salir-Whorf) who say that symbolic systems or universes - myths, languages, art, science, etc. - BUILD THE WORLD OF OBJECTS, which would be "SYMBOLIC TYPES". In this way, KNOWLEDGE APPEARS AS "ACTIVE", BUILDING (STRUCTURING) THE MATERIAL WORLD of things. The ideas of things determine and shape the things themselves. An author who also adheres to this vision is DURKHEIM, for whom there are no universal classifications of things, but rather social types, which are arbitrary because they are related to a specific group in a given society.



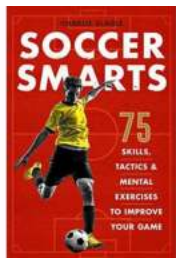
