Therefore, the GCF is $2^4 = 16$.

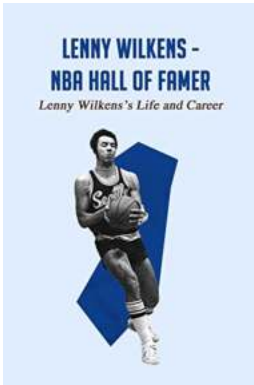
If we divide the numerator and denominator by 16, then we will simplify in 1 step!

$$\frac{144}{256} = \frac{9}{16}$$

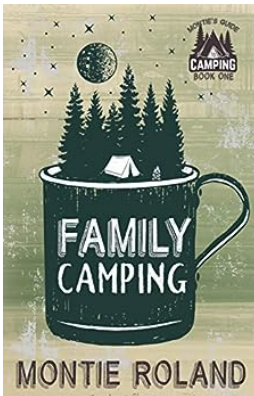
